### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

#### First aid measures for different exposure routes

##### Eye contact

Rinse with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately if irritation persists. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician.
